





At the start of Daniel's 70th Week, a world ruler rose to power and made a 7-year Covenant of Peace and Security, promising to protect the Jews and help rebuild the Temple in Jerusalem.




^{*}Antichrist breaks covenant with Israel and becomes their **persecutor** instead of **protector**.

SECOND COMING

Revelation Chapter 19 discusses the Second Coming of Christ and the Battle of Armageddon



³⁰ Then the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. ³¹ And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son, and shall call His name JESUS. ³² He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Most High; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David. ³³ And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end."

Do God's Promises Count?

- The Davidic Covenant (2 Sam 7:11-16).
- David's royal dynasty (Isa 7:13).
- David's eternal throne (2 Sam 7:13, 16, 19; 1 Chr 17:12; 22:10; Isa 55:3; Ezek 37:25).
- A political kingdom (Gen 17:2-8), even confirmed by oath (Ps 132:11; 89:3, 4, 34). (This cannot be applied to the Church per Ezekiel 37:21-28).
- The future throne that was recognized by the First Church
- Council in Acts 15 (Acts 15:16-18, quoting Amos 9:11-12.
 Cf. Jer 30:7, 11, 19)
- Jude 1:14-15, quoting Enoch, a pre-Flood prophet.


19 After these things I heard a loud voice of a great multitude in heaven, saying,

³ Again they said,

"Alleluia*! Her smoke rises up forever and ever!"

* Greek form of Hebrew Hallelujah ("Praise Yahweh")



- ⁵ Then a voice came **from the throne**, saying,
 - "Praise our God, all you His servants and those who fear Him, both small and great!"
- And I heard, as it were, the voice of a great multitude, as the sound of many waters and as the sound of mighty thunderings, saying,
 - "Alleluia! For the Lord God Omnipotent reigns! ⁷ Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready."
- And to her it was granted to be arrayed in fine linen, clean and bright, for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints.

⁹ Then he said to me,

"Write: 'Blessed are those who are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb!"



And he said to me,

"These are the true sayings of God."

And I fell at his feet to worship him. But he said to me,

"See that you do not do that!*
I am your fellow servant, and of your brethren who have the testimony of Jesus.

"Worship God!

"For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy."



Christ on a White Horse

Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war.

"The Spirit of the Lord God is upon Me, because the LORD has anointed Me to preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound; ² to proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD and the day of vengeance of our God....


Isaiah 61:1-2



Jesus, reading at the synagogue at Nazareth (Luke 4:10-21), stopped at this comma and declared, "This day is this scripture fulfilled in your ears."

Jesus will now complete this mandate!

- ¹² His eyes were like a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns [diadem]. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself.
- ¹³ He *was* clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God.
- ¹⁴ And the armies in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, followed Him on white horses.
- ¹⁵ Now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations.



And He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron.


He Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

And He has on *His* robe and on His thigh a name written:

"Come and gather together for the supper of the great God,

18 that you may eat the flesh of kings, the flesh of captains, the flesh
of mighty men, the flesh of horses and of those who sit on them,
and the flesh of all *people*, free and slave, both small and great."



- And I saw the beast, the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against Him who sat on the horse and against His army.
- Then the beast was captured, and with him the false prophet who worked signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image. These two were cast alive into the lake of fire burning with brimstone.

And the rest were killed with the sword which proceeded from the mouth of Him who sat on the horse. And all the birds were filled with their flesh.

MILENNIUM MARKET STATES AND STATE

Revelation Chapter 20 frequently discusses a controversial thousand year period that we today call the "Millennium".

Comments on the 1,000 years

- Christ's reign on earth (AKA 1,000 years (Millennium)) is introduced. Regardless of your personal hermeneutics, read this Rev. 20 for what the Bible actually says.
- Revelation 20 mentions 1,000 years six times, but Revelation is not the only biblical passage where Christ's Kingdom comes up:
 - Promised to David (2 Sam 7:12-17; 23:5) under oath (Ps 89:34-37).
 - Predicted in the Psalms (Psalm 2; 110).
 - Predicted in the Prophets (Isa 2:1-5; 4:1-6; 11:1-9; 12:1-6; 30:18-26; 35:1-10; 60, 61:3-62; 66; Jer 23:3-8; 32:37-44; Ezek 40-48; Dan 2:44- 45; 7:13-14; 12:2-3; Micah 4:1-8; Zech 12:10-14; 14:9, 16-21; Zeph. 3:11; .
 - Promised to Mary (Lk 1:32; Micah 5:2; Isa 9:6, 7; Dan 2:44) and reaffirmed to apostles (Mt 19:28; Lk 22:29-30; 1 Cor 6:2).
 - Lord's Prayer: "Thy Kingdom come" (Mt 6:10, 13; Acts 1:6; Ps 45, 46, 47, 48).
 - Rule (Ps 2; 110); "Rod of Iron" (Rev 12:5; 19:15); "Every knee will bow," (Phil 2:6-11).

Eschatology worldviews

Idealism

(Amillennial)

Interprets Bible prophecies and imagery symbolically, allegorically, nonliterally.
(Origen, Augustine, Roman Catholicism, Orthodox, Mainstream Denominations today)

Preterism

(Post-Millennial)

Interprets Bible prophecies as events which have already happened; e.g., Antichrist was Nero (or Domitian) in 1st Century AD. (Luis de Alcazar (1554-1630))

Futurist

(Hyper-literalism)

Interprets prophecy as future events in literal, physical, apocalyptic context; e.g., Antichrist to come in far future. (Francisco Ribera (1537 - 1591))

Invented by Jesuits for the Counter-Reformation

Historicism

(Premillennial)

Interprets text as being fulfilled during current span of history. Some text is symbolic (idioms, (figures of speech), but emphasis is otherwise on literal interpretation. (Early Church, Reformers)

Post-Tribulation Rapture

Hermeneutics (Theory of Bible Interpretation)



- 20 Then I saw an angel coming down from heaven, having the key to the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand.
- He laid hold of the dragon, that serpent of old, who is the Devil and Satan, and bound him for a thousand years; ³ and he cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal on him, so that he should deceive the nations no more till the thousand years were finished.

But after these things he must be released for a little while.

The Saints Reign with Christ 1,000 Years

⁴ And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was committed to them.



Then I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for their witness to Jesus and for the word of God, who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received his mark on their foreheads or on their hands.

And they lived and reigned with Christ for a thousand years.

Four Saintly Categories

- Old Testament Saints (Dan 12:1-4; Isa 25:8-9)
- Believers/Overcomers (Rev 5:10; 2:26-28; 3:12, 21; 1 Thess 4:13-18; 2 Tim 2:12)
- Tribulation Martyrs (Rev 6:9)
- Tribulation Saints, living, "not worshipped the beast" (above)

⁵ But the rest of the dead did not live again until the **thousand years** were finished. This *is* the first resurrection.

There are two resurrections:

- Luke 14:14 "And you will be blessed, because they cannot repay you; for you shall be repaid at the resurrection of the just."
- Dan 12:2 "And many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, some to shame and everlasting contempt."
- In 5:28-29 "Do not marvel at this; for the hour is coming in which all who are in the graves will hear His voice and come forth—those who have done good, to the resurrection of life, and those who have done evil, to the resurrection of condemnation."
- Acts 24:15 "I have hope in God, which they themselves also accept, that there will be a resurrection of the dead, both of the just and the unjust."
- Luke 14:14 "And you will be blessed, because they cannot repay you; for you shall be repaid at the resurrection of the just."
- The first resurrection is a "category" (e.g., Jesus' resurrection, the open sepultures, the thief on the Cross, those in Abraham's Bosom & deceased believers afterwards, the Rapture), not a single event.

⁶ Blessed and holy *is* he who has part in the first resurrection. Over such the second death has no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ,



Two Categories of Death

1) First (Physical) Death: Separation of the body and soul.




Satanic Rebellion Crushed

⁹ They went up on the breadth of the earth and surrounded the camp of the saints and the beloved city. And fire came down from God out of heaven and devoured them.






The Great White Throne Judgment




¹¹ Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away. And there was found no place for them.

- And I saw the dead, small and great, standing before God, and books were opened. And another book was opened, which is the Book of Life. And the dead were judged according to their works, by the things which were written in the books.
- ¹³ The sea gave up the dead who were in it, and Death and Hades delivered up the dead who were in them.



The Bible refers to Two Books!
